

## Barbara Naugle - Grubb

### Community Affairs



Barbara graduated from Collinwood in June 1958. She married in 1960 and raised two children. Barbara worked at the May Company from 1970 to 1978 achieving the position of Credit Manager. From 1978 to 1987 she was employed as a purchasing agent for Vitramon, Inc. located in Connecticut. While living in Connecticut, Barbara served as a Board member of the Trumbull Women's Club from 1995 to 2002, as a Board member of the Monroe League of Women Voters from 1996 to 2002, and as a Board member of the Monroe Town Committee from 1986 to 2000.

Barbara and her family moved to Litchfield, Ohio in 2002 and she immediately became involved in community affairs in her new hometown. She began attending Litchfield Trustee meetings and Zoning Commission meetings. She was appointed Chairperson of the Zoning Board of Appeals. She served on the Medina County Advisory Council (Agency on Aging) as the Litchfield representative. She was the Chair of the Finance Committee for this Council from 2006 to 2009. She also was a member of the Bylaws Committee. She represented the Advisory Council on the Medina County Senior Levy Committee. Barbara also was an At-Large Committee member of Emergency Management Safety Committee/Medina County. In July 2009, Barbara was appointed to the Western Reserve Agency on Aging, representing Medina County. She served on the Finance and Public Policy Committees. As further evidence of her involvement in community affairs, Barbara served as a voting official for several years. In addition to her volunteer efforts in Medina County, Barbara served on the Board of Directors of the Rural Lorain County Water Authority. She was the Litchfield representative.

Barbara's volunteerism also was evidenced by her work at her church, Litchfield Assembly of God. She taught Sunday school and Wednesday Children's Missionettes classes. She assisted with all church fundraising activities and she instituted donations from Pepperidge Farms.

Barbara was an active member of the Collinwood High School Alumni Association serving as Membership Chairperson, Scholarship Committee member, and newsletter chairman. She worked with CHS officials to institute building tours for CHS alumni and friends. She also worked with school personnel on beautification projects for school grounds.
