


## Dr. Daniel C. Sterns, III

### Medicine



Dr. Daniel C. Sterns, III is a graduate of the January Class of 1939. As a Collinwood student he was a member of the National Honor Society, Sports Editor of "The Collinwood Spotlight", served as Senior Class Treasurer and was Master of Ceremonies at the 12B Prom.

After graduating, Dr. Sterns attended Ohio State University to study Veterinary Medicine and graduated during World War II in 1945. He volunteered with the United Nations to help the United States and Europe by providing veterinary services for the many' farm animals that were sent overseas to replenish European stock. Daniel retired as Captain in the Army Veterinary Corps Reserve.

In 1948, Dr. Sterns opened Euclid Veterinary Hospital, and is still working there six days a week, healing and caring for animals throughout Cuyahoga and Lake counties.

Since 1982 he has owned and operated Harmony Hill Farm in Southeast Ohio. This is his own breeding and training farm for thoroughbred horses and cattle. Daniel's farm has produced more winners of races than any other in the State of Ohio. One of his famous horses is "French Legionnaire", a grandson of "Secretariat"; and two of his many winning horses are "Collinwood Reunion" and "Railroader".

Dr. Sterns has served as the veterinarian for the Cleveland Mounted Police for fifty years. He is one of two trustees for the Trust Fund that has generated thousands of for charities concerned with the welfare of animals.

Daniel's service to the State of Ohio is evident by his being appointed four times to the Thoroughbred Race Fund Advisory Committee by former Governor James Rhodes. At Ohio State University, it was Dr. Sterns who suggested that the Ohio State Victory Bell be installed in the Ohio State Stadium in 1954.

As President of the Ohio Division of the Horseman's Benevolent and Protective Association, Dr. Sterns has traveled the world extensively in support of the welfare of animals.

Daniel is married to Nancy, his wife of fifty years; they have one son, Daniel.
