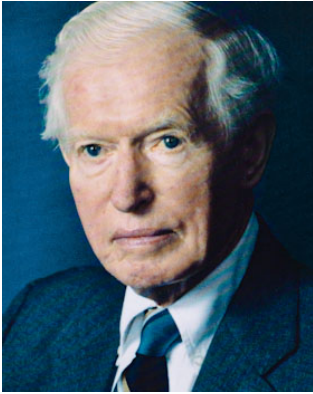


Dr. John Charles Cutler Science



Dr. Cutler graduated from Collinwood in '1933; then from the School of Medicine at Western Reserve in 1941. Later he obtained an additional medical degree in Public Health from Johns Hopkins University. Dr. Cutler served in the military as a commissioned in the U.S. Public Health Service, the U.S. Coast Guard, the World Health Organization and the Office of the Surgeon General of the United States.

His outstanding career as a professional medical practitioner, research director, and specialist in the public health field has been recognized by national and international scientific societies His research and publications on venereal disease have made him a foremost authority around the world.

In the past years Dr. Cutler has held the titles of Chairman, Director, Dean and Professor Emeritus at the Graduate School of Public Health at the University of Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania where he still resides with his wife.
