Daniel P. DiLiberto graduated from Collinwood High School in 1966. While at Collinwood he was involved in football, Student Council, and the Choral Club; he also served as a guard for lunch, movie, and study halls.

He attended Cuyahoga Community College and Lakeland Community College. Dan started the Lake County community newspapers and was elected to the Eastlake City Council in 1984. He served as Council President and also served on every council committee. Dan was a member of the Board of Directors of the Eastlake Chamber of Commerce, of which he was Vice President.

Dan was elected mayor of Eastlake in 1993, becoming the city's seventh mayor. He was the president of the Lake County Mayors and Managers Association for a number of years.

Dan is a past president of the Ohio Mayor's Association and president of the Northeast Ohio Mayor's Association.

He oversaw the building of Eastlake's new city hall as the building construction manager and was a leader in building the \$22 million Lake County Captain's Stadium, which will be an economic boon to the area for years to come.

He also created the "America Remembers Memorial" by collecting pieces of the World Trade Center, the Pentagon, and the fields in Shanksville, Pa.; it is the only memorial of its kind in the country. Dan has been married to Marilyn for 35 years and they have three children and four grandchildren.
